SAN BERNARDINO SUPERIOR COURT HOSTS 4th VIRTUAL TOWNHALL ON ELIMINATING BIAS

SAN BERNARDINO, CA—San Bernardino Superior Court's (SBSC) Community Outreach Committee is collaborating with local justice partners and county officials to host its fourth virtual townhall event focused on eliminating bias in the justice system. *Eliminating Bias: What Are We Doing for the Homeless?* is scheduled on Tuesday, October 19 from 12:00 p.m. (Noon) to 1:15 p.m.

During this 75-minute virtual townhall, leaders within the San Bernardino County justice system will continue the dialogue on bias and community impacts by answering questions and informing attendees of programs and services available to the public for family members, organizations, and individuals who are homeless. This will be the fourth virtual event since 2020 with the goal of promoting community engagement and conversations to foster awareness, change and understanding.

Opening remarks will be provided by Presiding Judge Michael A. Sachs, with moderation by Judge John M. Pacheco and Judge Winston Keh. Panelists include: Judge Ingrid Uhler; 5th District County Supervisor Joe Baca, Jr.; Dr. Veronica Kelley, Director of the Department of Behavioral Health; Linda Metz, Deputy District Attorney; and Daniel Edber, Deputy Public Defender IV.
